"A total of 12 studies were included in this systematic scoping review. Of these, five (n=5) employed qualitative study designs, five (n=5) were quantitative study designs, one (n=1) utilized a mixed-methods approach, and one (n=1) was a review."

The authors sincerely apologize for this error and any confusion it may have caused. This correction does not affect the findings or conclusions of the systematic scoping review.
